RECENT PROJECTS

NORTHEAST

PROJECT: BFI TANK

DESCRIPTION

Environmental investigation for loss of fuels.

WORKS

Ground investigation, sampling and mechanical excavation of trial pits as required to determine the possible source and extent of contamination in the area BFI slops tank, to determine potential contamination ingress to chambers and surface water drains.

SOUTHWEST

PROJECT: BFI TANK

DESCRIPTION

BFI internal and external tank clean, blasting and remedial works.

WORKS

Manned entry jet wash tank clean and certify gas free on 2 number BFI prior to shot blasting to SA 2.5 standards, apply sections of 350-400-micron Dura-Plate UHS to repair areas ensuring integrity, external and internal coating with approved Macropoxy. Completion of project on installation of new fuel probes and required ancillary equipment.

SOUTHWEST

PROJECT: MTFI SITE

DESCRIPTION

Decommission of an old and installation of a new Mechanical Transport Fuel Installation (MTFI).

WORKS

Empty, clean and decommission underground fuel storage tanks, decommissioning of fuel pumps and pipework, demolition of buildings and canopy, divert base firewater main supply around site, reinstate groundworks, drainage and civils, install new above ground fuel storage tanks and gantry with new pipework, fuel kiosk, ground fuel management system, lighting, electrical supply and lightning protection.

SOUTHWEST

PROJECT: AIRFRAME MAINTENANCE

DESCRIPTION

Chromate environmental testing and verification.

WORKS

Environmental monitoring and testing for Hexavalent Chromium (Chromate), within the airframe maintenance shed, using onsite swab tests and XRF scanning to verify areas of contamination and ongoing cleaning processes. Ongoing project over a period of months to ensure safe areas of working.
